Irwin Stanley Dockery, 80, of Lamar, Missouri, passed away at 4:30 p.m. Thursday, December 12, 2002 at Freeman West Hospital in Joplin, Missouri after a short illness.

Stan was born March 11, 1922 in Irwin, Missouri to Z.B. and Edna (Harmon) Dockery. He had lived the last 19 years in Lamar.
