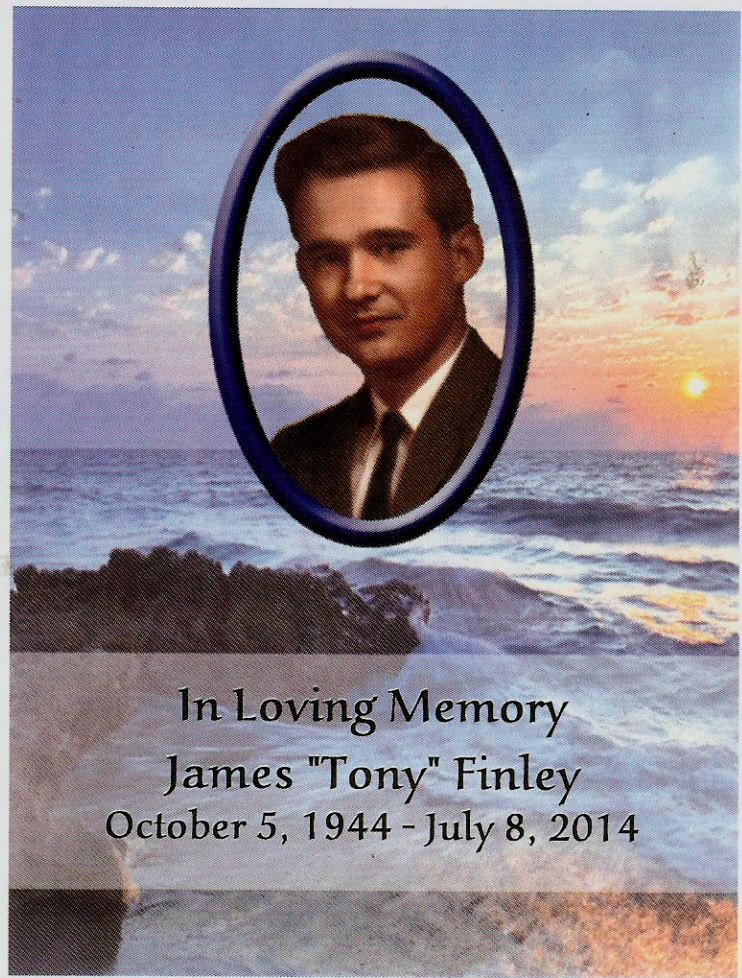

James Anthony "Tony" Finley, age 69, of Lamar, passed away Tuesday, July 8, 2014 at Freeman West Hospital in Joplin.
