LAMAR - George Lee Gardner, 58, Lamar, died at 7:25 p.m. Sunday at a local nursing home after a long illness.

Mr. Gardner was born Sept. 30, 1929, in Barton County to Harold Warren and Hazel (Skelton) Gardner. He lived in Barton County most of his life. He was a parts inspector at O'Sullivan Industries, Lamar, and a tool and die maker for Lawn Boy.

He was a Marine veteran of the Korean War. He was a member of the First Baptist Church in Lamar, a member of the Lamar Masonic Lodge and a former member of the Sheldon Masonic Lodge.

He married Mary Lou Danley on March 23, 1954, at Eureka Springs, Ark. She survives.

Additional survivors include two brothers, Bill Gardner and Bob Gardner, both of Lamar.

Services were at 11 a.m. Wednesday at the First Baptist Church in Lamar. The Rev. Ken Roller officiated.

Military services were conducted. Burial was in St. James Cemetery, north of Milford.

Masonic services were held at 7:30 p.m. Tuesday at Daniel Funeral Home.
