



Donaldean Gould, age 85, of Galesburg, Illinois passed away at 5:10 a.m. Friday, December 5, 2003 at Heartland Health Care Center, Galesburg, Illinois.

Donaldean was born August 20, 1918 in Lamar, Missouri to Donald B. and Gertrude (Stone) O'Neal. On January 17, 1947 in Lamar, Missouri she married Edward C. Gould, who preceded her in death November 25, 1997.

Donaldean was a 1935 graduate of Lamar High School and attended Kansas State College. She was a bank teller in Lamar, MO for 16 years, where she lived for 45 years of her life. She moved to Galesburg in 1963. She became a Welcome Wagon Representative and during her 31-year career, she visited with more than 9000 newcomers to the Galesburg and Knoxville areas.

Donaldean was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Galesburg, where she was a former president of the United Methodist Women and had served as chairperson of the United Methodist Kindness Circle. She was a member of the Galesburg Women's club, Welcome Wagon, numerous bridge clubs and was a charter member of the Home Extension "Yearn to Learn" unit.
