

Scott Hamilton was born October 15, 1904 in the Mt. Carmel neighborhood of Barton County, Missouri to George and Nettie Viola Hutchison Hamilton. He died 4:15 am. Saturday, January 22, 2000 at Dade County Nursing Home in Greenfield, Missouri after a long illness. **Scott** was preceded in death by his parents, his first wife, Gayle, his second wife, Florence, and his brother, John "Pete". He was 95 years, 2 months and 7 days old.

Scott farmed in the early part of his life. He married Mollie Gayle Spencer on March 27, 1937. **Scott** moved to Golden City in 1939 and owned and operated the pool hall until retirement in 1964. During his retirement he did janitorial work for First National Bank in Golden City and maintained three cemeteries in the area. **Scott** was always doing good deeds for other people and was a collector of antiques. During the 1960's he worked for the city of Golden City in various volunteer positions and in 1962 was given the "Man of the Year" award by the Chamber of Commerce. His wife, Gayle preceded him in death on January 13, 1969.

Scott married Florence Wastell Moyer on December 20, 1969 in Golden City, Missouri. She preceded him in death in 1993.

Scott enjoyed fishing and hunting. He also enjoyed trading knives and guns, and repairing antique clocks.

Scott is survived by his step son, Bill Moyer, Golden City, Missouri, his step daughter, Barbara Wilson, Prairie Village, Kansas, his two sisters, Lulu Bay, Findley, Ohio and Emma Everitt, Joplin, Missouri, five step grandchildren and ten step great grandchildren. Other relatives, friends, and neighbors will treasure the memories of this caring man.
