

Lorraine Ruth Jones, age 94, of Joplin, passed away at 11:45 p.m. Saturday, April 14, 2001 at Freeman West hospital following an illness.

Mrs. Jones was born March 21, 1907 at Alba, Missouri and had lived in Joplin since 1986. At an early age, Lorraine and her family moved to Everton, MO.
