James "Jimmy" Albert Miller, 89, Lamar, Missouri, passed away Wednesday, August 22, 2007, at 9:00 p.m. at the Mt Vernon Veterans Home in Mt Vernon, Missouri after a two year illness.

Jimmy was born April 1, 1918 in the Forest Grove Community, south of Lamar, Missouri to Alexander and Hattie (Keltner) Miller. He was in the US Army for four years, serving 22 months in active duty. He had worked for Lawn Boy in Lamar for 12 ½ years and for O'Sullivan's 18 ½ years before retiring at the age of 65.

Jimmy married Adaline J. Aiken on November 4, 1945 in Asheville, North Carolina. She preceded him in death on February 3, 1976.
