

Clyde D. White, age 80, of 80 Northwest 53rd Lane, Iantaha, Missouri, passed away at 2:40 a.m. Wednesday, March 6, 2002 at Barton County Memorial Hospital. He had been ill for the past five months.

Born October 15, 1921 in Grainola, Oklahoma, he was the son of George Robert and Ester Cora (Putman) White. Clyde was a World War II veteran who served in the U.S. Army. He was a farmer and had worked at Lawn Boy. He later retired as manager of the MFA Fertilizer Plant in Iantaha. He was a member of Lamar VFW Post #3691 and Iantaha Baptist Church where he served as Deacon and Sunday School Superintendent.
