Wilburn Benjamin Wilhelm, 82, of Lamar, Missouri, passed away at 1:40 p.m., Saturday, May 26, 2001 at the Barton County Memorial Hospital in Lamar.

Mr. Wilhelm was born April 1, 1919 in Lockwood, Missouri to Fritz and Pearl (Franklin) Wilhelm. He had been a lifetime resident of this area.
