- 2nd for Moderator. Philip Briggs was unanimously and chosen
- 3rd for Church Clerk. D. M. Briggs unanimously and chosen
- 4th Motion made that the Church shall be called Pleasant-View Baptist Church seconded and carried
- 5th Time of regular Church Covenant meeting to be Saturday before the first Sunday in each month at 3 O'Clock P.M.
- 6th The Organization being complete the Doors of the Pleasant-View Baptist Church were considered open and an invitation given for members Seven were received. Two by rotation and five as candidates for Baptism
- 7th Motion to adjourn. Seconded & carried
