4th

Of the Way of Salvation. - that the salvation
of sinners is wholly of grace, through the
mediatorial office of the son of God, who
took upon him our nature, yet without sin;
honored the law by his personal obedience,
and made atonements for our sins by his
death; being risen from the dead, he is now
enthroned in heaven; and uniting in his
wonderful person the tenderest sympathies
with divine perfection. is ever ready & willing
to be a suitable, a compassionate, and an
all sufficient Saviour

5th

Of Justification. - that the great gospel
blessings, which Christ of his fulness
bestowed on such as believe in Him, is
justification; that justification consists in
the pardon of sin, and the promise of eternal
life, on principles of righteousness; that it
is bestowed not in consideration of any works
of righteousness which we have done, but
solely through his own redemption and
righteousness; that it brings us into a state
of most blessed peace and favor with God
and secures every other blessing needful for
time and eternity.

6th

Of the Freedom of Salvation. - that the
blessings of Salvation are made free to all by
the gospel; that it is the immediate duty of
all to accept them by a cordial and abiding
faith, and that the gospel presents the salvation
