

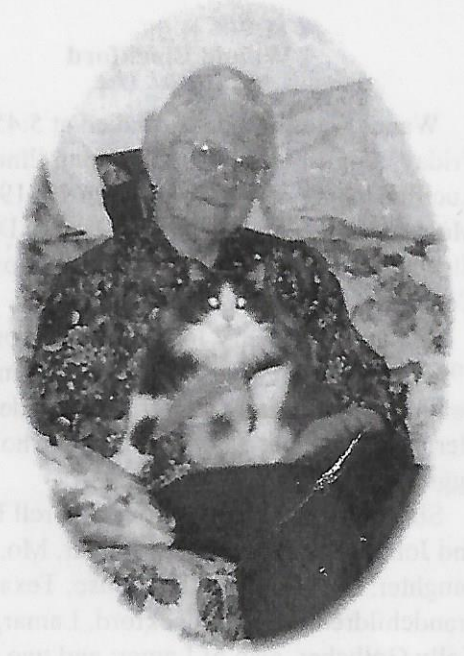
S. Oneta Campbell, age 95, of Washington, Iowa died Sunday, November 8, 2009 at the United Presbyterian Home.
