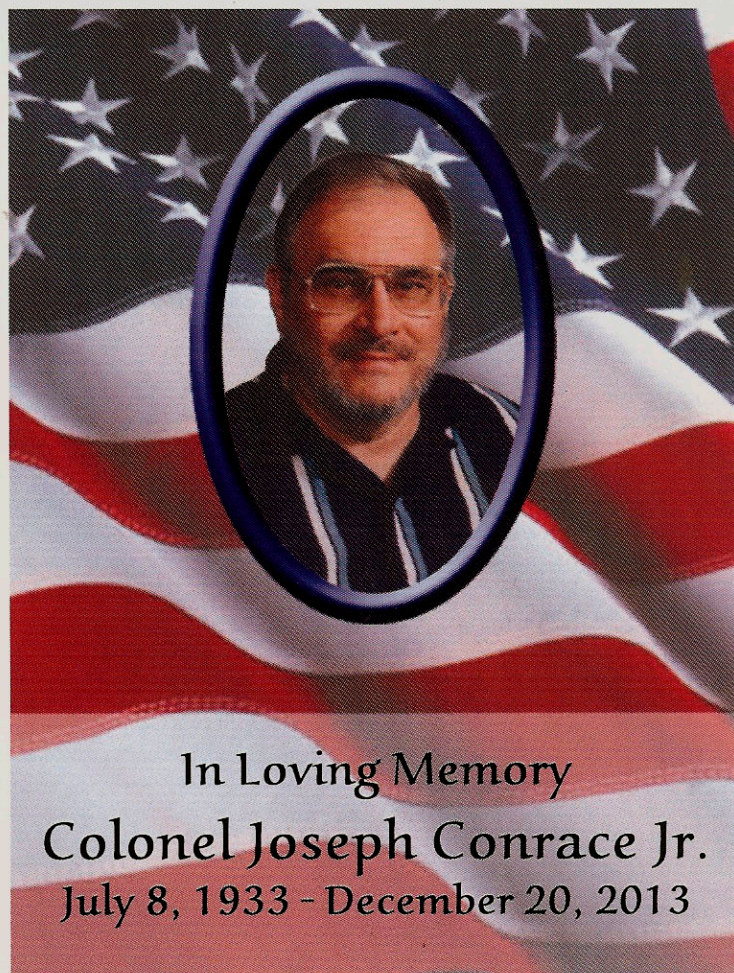

Colonel Joseph Ettore Cornacchione Conrace, Jr, age 80 of Lamar, passed away Friday, December 20, 2013 at Missouri Veterans Home in Mount Vernon following a long illness.

Joe was born July 8, 1933 at Richmond, Virginia, the only child of Joseph and Lillian (Litzenburger) Conrace. On his quest to become a child psychiatrist, Joe graduated from New Mexico Military Institute, the University of Virginia and Kansas City College of Osteopathy and Surgery. During his military career, Colonel Conrace served as an armored officer and child psychiatrist in Germany and various state-side U.S. Army Posts. He also spent many years in private practice psychiatry. In addition to membership in several professional organizations, Dr. Conrace was a 32nd Degree Mason in the Blue Lodge in Kansas City. He was an avid reader and enjoyed golf and tennis. A licensed lay reader, Dr. Conrace was an active member of Grace Episcopal Church in Carthage.

On June 19, 1971, at Kansas City, Missouri, Joe married Eva Susan Walters, and she survives, of the home.
