

Linn F. Crockett, age 86, of Miller, Missouri, passed away at 6:10 p.m. Monday, November 13, 2006, at his home.

Linn was born March 20, 1920, in Iantha, Missouri, to C.O. and Ethel (Brown) Crockett. He graduated from Mindenmines High School and served overseas as a medic and clerk in the U.S. Army during World War II. On June 29, 1943, at Gold Hill, Oregon, he married Anita Suiter. Linn worked for the Missouri State Highway Department for twenty-nine years in several locations.
