Survivors include a brother, George, and his wife, Helen Diggs, Lamar; a sister, Elizabeth Stillings, Atchison, Kan.; sister-in-law, Mildred Diggs, Lamar; and several nieces and nephews.

Mr. Diggs was born November 25, 1902, at Arrow Rock, the eldest son of Will T. and Bessye (McCart) Diggs. The family moved to the Oakton community in 1909 after their farm near Arrow Rock was destroyed by two previous years of Missouri River floods.

Mr. Diggs received his education at Oakton Grammar School, Carthage High School, graduating in 1922, and Draughn's Business College, Springfield. After serving as an accountant in a feed and seed store in Afton, Okla. for a time, he returned to Oakton for what he enjoyed most, farming.

He married Hildreth H. Cook on July 15, 1928, at Girard, Kan. In 1930 they purchased a farm two miles south of his parents' home and lived there until retirement. He was an active member of the Oakton Methodist Church throughout the years. Mrs. Diggs died on August 22, 1980. Mr. Diggs later sold the farm and moved into Lamar.
