Cecil Robert Disney son of David T. and Charlotte R. Roberts was born in Beaver County, Oklahoma on July 8, 1927. He died November 5, 1995 at 11:15 p.m. at the Broken Arrow Medical Center in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma. He was preceded in death by his parents and one sister, Iris Priest in 1961. Cecil was 68 years, 3 months and 28 days old.

Cecil lived in Oklahoma and Marshall County, Missouri in his younger years. He graduated from Princeton High School and went to college one year. Cecil will be missed by his wife, Marie, and his three stepsons, Roger Hurrell of Jasper, Missouri; Richard Hurrell of Golden City; and Randy Hurrell of Joplin, Missouri; one brother, David Disney of Golden City, Missouri; 13 step grandchildren and 14 step great grandchildren. Several nieces, nephews, other family members, neighbors and friends will cherish his memory.
