"Come to Me"

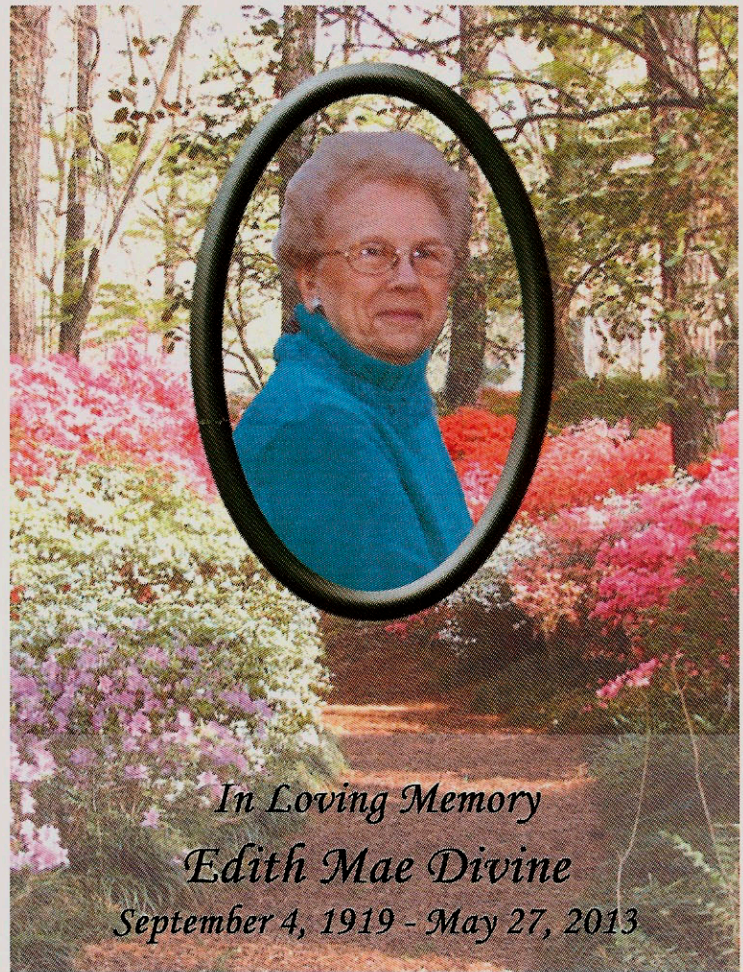
With tearful eyes
