

Everett Forest "Fuzzy" Felkner, age 90 of rural Lamar, passed away at 11:00 p.m. Sunday, March 16, 2008, at St. John's Regional Medical Center in Joplin.

Forest was born August 24, 1917, in Mulberry, Kansas, to Marvin and Sylvia (Cloud) Felkner. When Forest was four years old, his mother died, and most of his childhood was spent with his great-grandparents east of Milford, Missouri. On March 31, 1937, at Lamar, he married Reba Beatrice Smith, and they celebrated 68 years together before Reba's death May 21, 2005. He was also preceded in death by his two sons, Donald Felkner in 1994, and Everett Felkner, Jr. in 2001.

Fuzzy had worked as a tool & die machinist for Lawn Boy and later for O'Sullivan Industries, retiring in 1982. He enjoyed life in the country, raising top-quality quarter horses and mules. He trained hunting dogs and was an avid quail, turkey, & deer hunter. He was a member of Bethany Baptist Church and had also attended Newport Baptist Church.

Survivors include a daughter-in-law, Retha Felkner Squires, Lamar; two grandsons, Everett "Skipper" Felkner, III and his wife, Tina, and Joe Felkner, all of Lamar; a sister, Frances Toalson, Hallsville, Missouri; and five great-granddaughters, Melissa, Jennifer, Crystal, Amanda Jo, and Sarah.
