

Billy Lee Hackney, age 78, of Liberal, passed away Monday, March 15, 2010, at Good Shepherd Nursing Home in Lockwood.

Bill was born July 22, 1931, in Moundville, Missouri, the third of the four sons of Zuber and Agnes (Dozer) Hackney. A life-long area resident, Bill graduated from Liberal High School in 1949. He was drafted into the U.S. Marine Corp and served in Japan during
