

Mary Ethel Hagins, 85, passed away December 11, 2006, at Truman Healthcare. Mary Ethel was born on April 11, 1921, near Milford, to Clarence Byron Robinson and Mary Ann (Schenk) Robinson. She lived most of her life in Dade County, near Jerico Springs. She was a devoted mother, grandmother and great grandmother.
