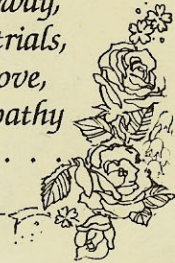


God hath not promised

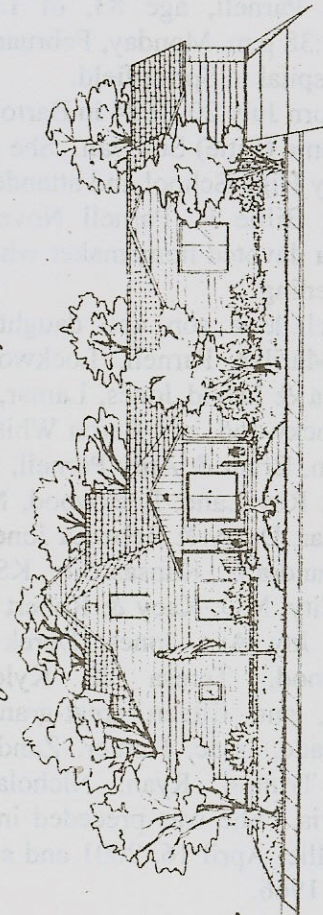
