

Henry L. Lisle passed away on March 7 at the Christian Health Care nursing home in Nevada, MO where he resided for the past nine months. He was 89 years old.

Mr. Lisle was preceded in death by his wife of more than 50 years, Theresa. He is survived by daughter, Susan Hobbs, and her husband, James, of Bellevue, NE, and son, William Lisle, and his wife, Mary, of Lamar. Mr. Lisle also leaves six grandchildren and seven great grandchildren.

Mr. Lisle was born October 1, 1913, in Butler, MO to Harris and Nell Lisle. He was the oldest of three children and is survived by one sister, Regina Austin, of Dallas, TX. His brother, Robert, preceded him in death.

Mr. Lisle attended the University of Missouri in Columbia and earned a degree of Juris Doctorate in 1937. After working for The Travelers Insurance Company, Mr. Lisle served as a special agent with the Federal Bureau of Investigation from 1939 through 1947. During World War II he was assigned to offices in Newark, NJ, Providence, RI, and St. Louis where he investigated cases involving foreign espionage.

He and his wife, TC, moved to Lamar in 1947 when he accepted a position as an attorney with the Horton Engineering Company. During that time he also served as a representative to the Missouri State Legislature from 1964-1968.

Mr. Lisle also was the Associate Circuit Judge for Barton County until his retirement in 1982.

He was a member Lamar Methodist Church, the Lamar Rotary Club and the Society of Former FBI Agents.

Mr. Lisle enjoyed quail hunting and was an accomplished marksman, successfully competing in national trap competitions. He also was an avid golfer who was a charter member of the Lamar
