

## SIXTEEN YEAR OLD BOY DIES OF HEART ATTACK

Albert Robert Lucas, sixteen, died at the home of his mother, Mrs. Minnie Lucas, near Iantha at 6:00 a.m. Sunday. The sixteen year old boy's death resulted from a heart attack. He became ill last Wednesday, but no one believed that there was anything seriously wrong with him. However, he continued to feel bad and grew quite weak. Early Sunday morning he called for someone to come and raise him up.

When a member of the family came at once to the boy's assistance, he was raised up in bed but in a few moments he fell back dead. It is rather unusual to hear of a fatal heart seizure in the case of a sixteen year old.

The boy was the son of the late Steve Lucas, who died a year ago last April. He was born July 1, 1930, near Jasper.

He leaves his mother, four brothers and six sisters. The brothers are Clarence and Lee of the home, Everett of Kansas City, Kansas, and Lawrence of California. The sisters are Mrs. Dorothy Bruffey and Mrs. Cecil Funk of Lamar, Mrs. Esther Griggs of Carthage, Mrs. Helen Carr who makes her home in Oregon and Annabelle and Mary Lucas of the home.

The body was taken to the Gibson Chapel to be prepared for burial. Funeral services were announced to take place Tuesday afternoon at the Gibson Chapel with interment to be in Waters Cemetery.
