

Marjorie Mezel, age 92, of Lamar, died Tuesday June 8, 2010 at St. John's Regional Medical Center in Joplin after a short illness.

Marjorie was born August 16, 1917 at Mulberry, KS to James and Helen Ann (Campbell) McCulloch. She was a graduate of Mulberry High School. As a young woman she had worked as a waitress in Excelsior Springs, MO, in

clerical and accounting for a railroad company, and during WWII she worked at an airplane assembly plant in Oakland, CA. On May 3, 1954, she married James William Mezel at Rock Island, IL. He preceded her in death, October 8, 1976. Marjorie was a stay at home mom, raising her five children.
