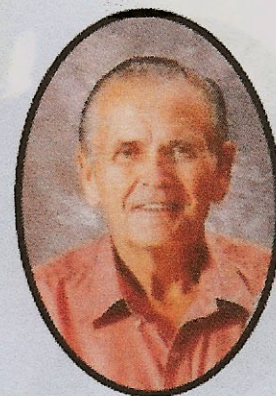
1 I waited patiently for the LORD;
