

## **Raymond Morgan**

Clarence Raymond Morgan, 92, died at 1:44 P.M. Sunday, January 9, 2000 at Barton County Memorial Hospital. Raymond was born August 25, 1907 in Barton County, Missouri to George Sherman and Caroline Elizabeth (Mitchell) Morgan and grew up in the area. He lived in Rich Hill, Missouri for 45 years where he was a bulk oil distributor for Phillips 66 for 17 years and then on his own with Morgan Oil Company for 14 years.
