



Victor LaVerne Probert was born January 9, 1927 to James Arthur and Bernice Edwina Hubbard Probert in Jasper County, Missouri. He died Tuesday morning, September 2, 1997 at 7:40 a.m. at the McCune-Brooks Hospital in Carthage, Missouri after a long illness. **LaVerne** was preceded in death by his parents, a brother, Joe Probert and two sisters, Pauline Stansberry and Dorothy Kelley and an infant sibling. He lived his entire life of 70 years, 7 months and 23 days in the Jasper and Barton county area.

LaVerne entered the Army in 1945, though World War II ended as he was on his way to Europe. He served as an MP with the rank of corporal in Italy after the Liberation. He was discharged from the service in November of 1946.
