

Eugene C. Robertson, age 87, of Lamar, passed away at 6:03 p.m. Tuesday, February 13, 2007 at Barton County Memorial Hospital following a sudden illness while working at his farm.

Eugene was born December 10, 1919, in Kansas City, Missouri, to Frank E. and Lottie Mae (Adams) Robertson. In 1925, when Gene was six years old, his family moved to Barton County. He was a U.S. Navy veteran of World War II, serving from 1942 until 1946.
