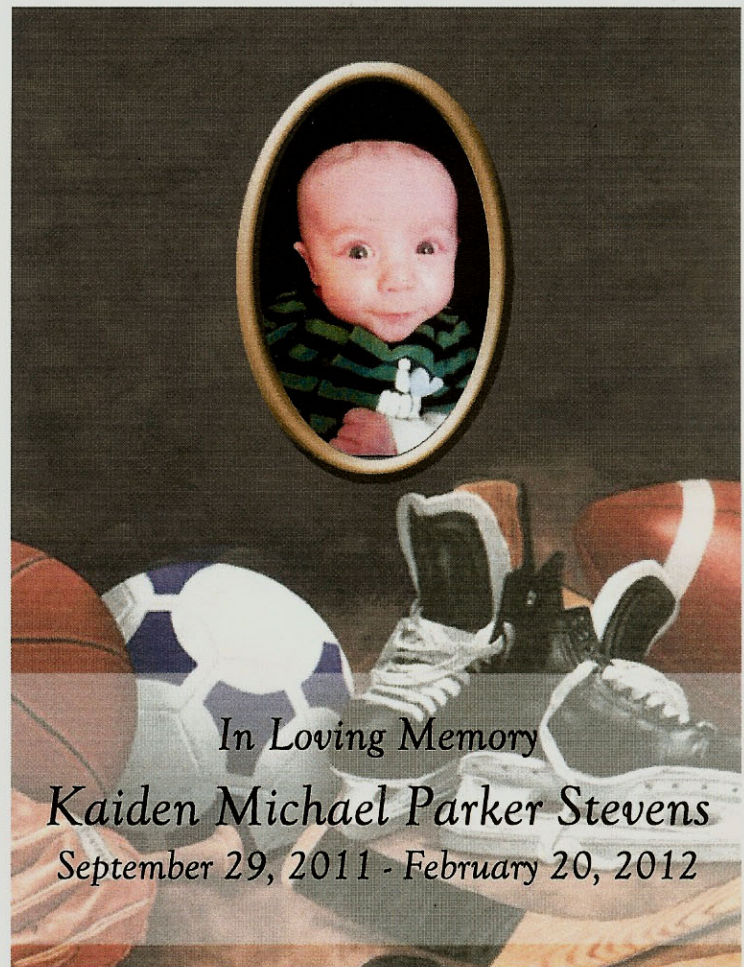


## APPRECIATION
