



Bobby Lee Stevenson, age 74, of Lamar, passed away at 1:30 p.m. Monday, October 22, 2007 at his home.

Bobby was born July 22, 1933, in the Newport community, to Clarence and Agnes (Gardner) Stevenson. He graduated from Lockwood High School in 1951 and worked as a glass cutter and glazer at Meeks Lumber in Lockwood. From 1953 through 1955, during the Korean War, Bobby served in the U.S. Army. Returning home, he again worked for Meeks, was a glass cutter in St. Joseph for a few years, worked for Community Lumber and Walt Cook Construction in Lamar for many years. Bobby then worked for O'Sullivan Industries for 19 years, retiring in 2003.

A life-long Barton county resident, Bobby enjoyed hunting and fishing. He was an accomplished woodworker and an avid bowler. Bobby was a member of Lamar VFW Post 3691 and Milford Christian Church.
