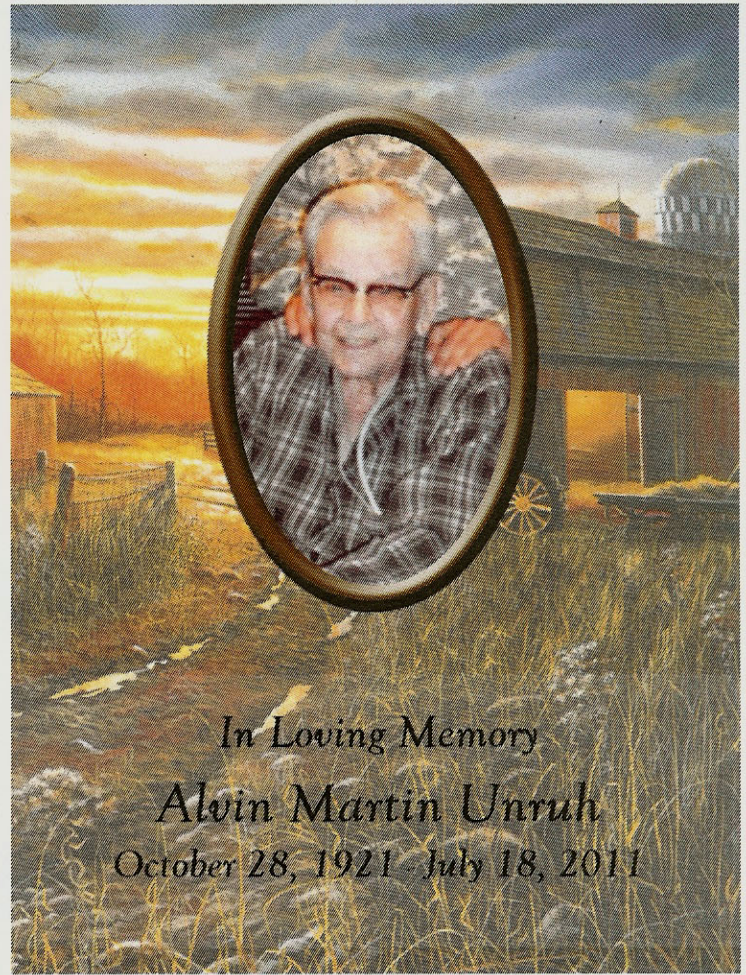

Alvin Martin Unruh, age 89, of Lamar, died Monday July 18, 2011 at Barton County Memorial Hospital after a long illness.
