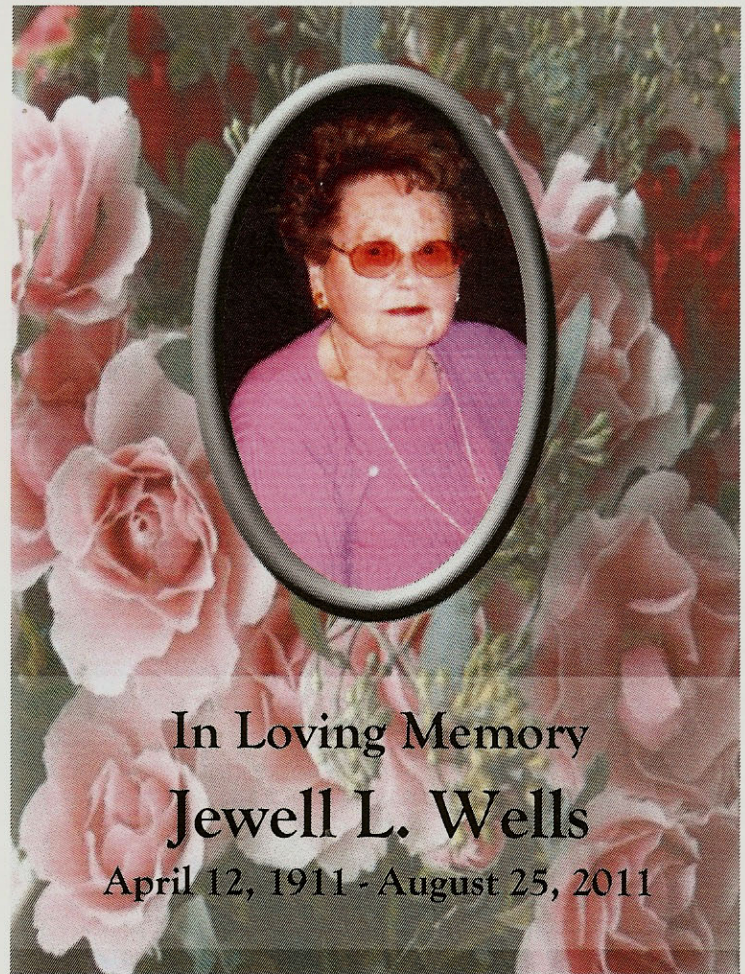

Jewell L. Wells, age 100, of Lamar, passed away Thursday, August 25, 2011 at her home.

Jewell was born April 12, 1911, at Iantha, Missouri, to Harvey and Edna (Burr) DeHart. She graduated from Lamar High School with the class of 1929 and furthered her education at Pittsburg State College and Kansas City Business College. On May 4, 1931, at Kansas City, Jewell married Louis Wells, and they made their home in Independence, Missouri for forty years. She worked as a secretary in the Kansas City School District for 27 years and was an assistant in the Independence office of motor vehicle registration for several years.
